



WAYNE COUNTY FIRE CHIEFS APPARATUS FEE SCHEDULE STANDARD OPERATING GUIDELINE

January 01, 1997

The following is the adopted cost recovery fees structure to be used for all Wayne County Fire & EMS Departments on all cost recovery situations that should accrue in Wayne County.

It is the recommendation that all Wayne County Fire Departments adopt the fee schedule and put it in to their Department S.O.G.s in the event that a fee structure should be required on any calls in the future.

ENGINE	\$200.00 per hour
AERIAL	\$250.00 per hour
TANKER	\$200.00 per hour
SPECIAL SERVICE SUPPORT UNIT	\$150.00 per hour
BASIC EMS UNIT	\$100.00 per hour
ADVANCED EMS UNITS	\$125.00 per hour
PARAMEDIC EMS UNIT	\$150.00 per hour
PICKUP OR GRASS UNITS	\$100.00 per hour
BOATS OR SNOWMOBILES (Price includes cost of a tow vehicle)	\$150.00 per hour
LIGHT PLANTS (Price includes cost of a tow vehicle)	\$125.00 per hour
STAFF VEHICLES (Chief, Prevention, other Staff)	\$50.00 per hour

** - This may vary from department to department since it will be determined by the current pay scale of the department involved (Full time, Paid on call or Volunteer) and weather that member is in on overtime or not. Departments that do not pay their members by the hour should establish an hourly rate of \$15.00 per hour to be used for invoicing purposes and incorporate it into this document.

A 10% Administrative Fee may be required and added by each Department.

This fee scale should be approved by all departments governing body for approval. This will ensure that no problems arise in the event that billing should be required.
